Sophie rose to fame in 2001 with her first double platinum selling solo album 'Read My Lips'. Three singles from the album achieved top three status in the singles chart. The record went on to sell over 2 million copies worldwide and is still a fan favourite to this day.

The band program has also earned several Gold ratings and Sweepstakes Awards in national competitions held in Nashville, Atlanta, Toronto, Orlando, New York City, and Chicago.



BROOKWOOD HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND GEORGIA, USA

The Brookwood Bronco Marching Band regularly involves over 250 students from all band classes and school populations. They seek to deliver an organisation that includes students of all levels and abilities and provides a quality experience, as well as opportunities to develop as advanced musicians and good citizens. Throughout the years, the band have been awarded nine Grand Championships from local and regional competitors. The Brookwood Bronco Marching Band's first international performance was at LNYDP 2017 and the crowd loved them so much, LNYDP had to bring them back for the TV spectacular!



LONDON CHINATOWN CHINESE ASSOCIATION

The London Chinatown Chinese Association has been representing the beating heart of London's historic Chinese community since 1978. The association was founded with the aim of developing and expanding businesses in Chinatown, and providing a wide range of essential services for the Chinese population living in the UK. Today they are most proud of the Chinese New Year Celebrations in Chinatown, which has now officially been recognised as the largest Chinese New Year celebration held outside of Asia. Their sensational dancing dragons and lions are over 30 feet long and are most definitely showstoppers. They undeniably brought their authentic Chinese culture and celebrations to LNYP this year!



KINETIKA BLOCO



Kinetika Bloco is a performance group with an exuberant mix of young brass and woodwind players, drummers, steelpanners and dynamic dancers all in costume creating a “unique British Carnival sound with a decidedly London edge”. They were established as a charity in June 2010, but have been in existence since 2000, when it was first established as a project within Kinetika Art Links International.

The group draws influence from the Caribbean, Brazil, West and Southern Africa, New Orleans Jazz, Funk and Hip Hop.

Their achievements include performances at The Notting Hill Carnival, Bestival and The London Jazz Festival, headlining The Roundhouse, performing for Nelson Mandela who called the group “enchanting”, representing the UK at The Beijing Olympic Festival and leading Team GB in the London 2012 Victory Parade.



JAMIE CULLUM



Since releasing his best-selling album 'Pointless Nostalgic' in 2002, Jamie has become a household name Jazz musician, consistently winning a variety of music awards along the way.

Although primarily a Jazz musician, Jamie performs in a wide range of styles and is generally regarded as a "crossover" artist with his musical roots firmly based in Jazz.

As well as The White Stripes and Kanye West, Cullum has produced music for Massive Attack, Pharrell Williams, Rihanna and The Pussycat Dolls to name a few.

Jamie's brand new Christmas album 'The Pianoman at Christmas' is out now and LNYP were able to receive an exclusive performance of his new single 'Hang Your Lights'.

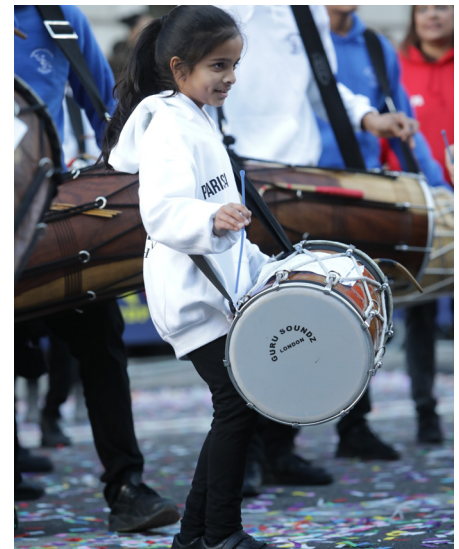


LONDON SCHOOL OF DHOL

His poetry has been published in *The Poetry Review*, *Poetry London*, *New Statesman*, *Granta* and elsewhere. His work has also appeared on *BBC Newsnight*, *BBC Radio 4*, *ITV*, *VICE UK*, *Channel 4* and *Sky Arts*.

He was awarded the 2019 H-100 Award for writing and publishing and the 2015 Groucho Maverick Award for his poetry and fiction. In 2019, he was made an honorary fellow of the University of Roehampton. Anthony is the artistic director of *Out-Spoken*, a monthly poetry and music night held at London's Southbank Centre and publisher of *Out-Spoken Press*.

They provide dance, drumming, costume making and much more in their weekly dance, drumming classes and workshops. Each year they participate in the Notting Hill Carnival as well as other prestigious parades and perform at live shows and gigs. The school is linked to Brazil through their 'godmother' school Mocidade, which won the 2017 Rio De Janeiro Carnival competition. They have been featured in many magazines, newspapers and on British TV shows, including Dancing on Ice and Strictly Come Dancing. Their bright costumes, all of which are handmade by their Samba dancers, will surely put a smile on your face!

America's Clogging All Stars are already planning international trips in the near future.

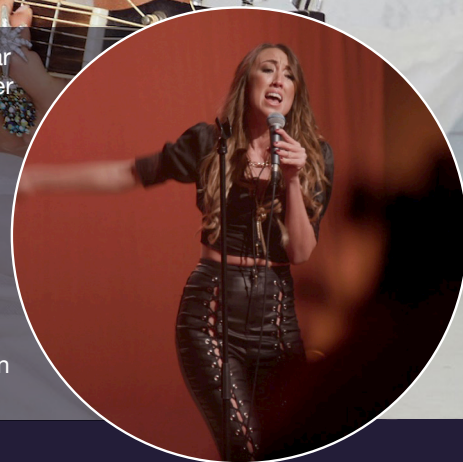


HARLEymoon KEMP

Harley comes from an esteemed musical background, with pop-star and actor father, Martin Kemp, who is most notable for his lead role in 80's pop sensation group, Spandau Ballet. Mother Shirley Kemp, was also formerly one half of 80's pop duo Pepsi & Shirley.
