

Day 1

Afternoon: Depart from the USA.

Day 2

Morning: Arrive in Paris. Coach to your hotel, check-in and settle in.

Afternoon: Find out all about your week in Paris and explore your hotel and the surrounding area.

Evening: Parisienne dinner of local specialities. Visit the Eiffel Tower. Take the lift to the 2nd floor for views out across Paris.

Day 3

Morning: Buffet breakfast in the hotel.

Panoramic Tour of Paris to all the famous landmarks including musical locations within the city.

Afternoon: Independent lunch in Paris. Independent shopping and sightseeing around central Paris.

Evening: Dinner in Paris.

Attend a concert in a church in Paris.

Day 4

Morning: Buffet breakfast in the hotel.

Tour of the Louvre Museum, home to Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa and the Vénus de Milo.

Afternoon: Independent lunch in Paris.

Technical rehearsal at your performance location in Paris.

Evening: Performance.

Dinner near performance location in Paris either before or after the concert.

Day 5

Morning: Buffet breakfast in the hotel.

Full day trip to Versailles. Located 45 minutes by coach from Paris, this day trip includes a 2.5 hour guided tour around the Chateau, and time in the afternoon to explore the Versailles Gardens, Royal Opera and Marie Antoinettes Estate, bus transportation back to Paris.

Evening: Dinner in a creperie (pancake house) in Paris.

Day 6

Morning: Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Tour of the Palais Garnier, the Opera House of Paris.

Afternoon: Independent lunch in Paris Technical rehearsal at your performance location in Paris.

Evening: Performance. Dinner near performance location in Paris either before or after the concert.

Day 7

Morning: Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Visit to the Musee de la Musique housing a collection of over 8,000 instruments and works of art within the Philharmonie de Paris.

Afternoon: Independent lunch in Paris. Visit Montmartre. Take the funiculaire up to Montmartre to explore the winding streets and visit the Roman Catholic Basilica of Sacre Coeur.

Evening: Final night dinner in Montmartre with musical entertainment.

Day 8

Morning: Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Return to the USA.
